The Bessie Boccock Carter Conservation Award Guidelines

1. Must be a project to conserve natural resources or protect the environment.
2. Must benefit a local community, or the whole of the Commonwealth of Virginia.
3. The minimum award amount shall be \$4,000.00.
4. A member of the GCV Conservation Awards Committee will be the liaison to the project, and may visit periodically.
5. The entire GCV Conservation Awards Committee may visit the project upon completion.
6. The project should be completed within two years of the award.
7. Recipient will report on the project's progress at the subsequent Board of Governors meeting until completion.
8. Projects other than the recipient may be resubmitted.
